Dear Parents,

As a parent myself, I know that you may have anxiety about your student and wonder what Foxcroft Academy is doing to take care of your child during this coronavirus pandemic. I want to assure you that we have a staff that cares very much about the students and all steps are being taken to ensure that your child is safe, well, and receiving the very best education and residential setting.

At the time of writing this letter, there have not been any confirmed cases of the coronavirus in the State of Maine. We expect this to change and are planning accordingly. Here are some important informational points that I would like to share with you:

- International travel, national travel, and in-state travel are restricted at this time. Your student will be allowed to shop in town and possibly in the surrounding areas and we will continue to monitor the situation to see when travel can be reinstated.
- Learning will continue and the students will have access to the Academy's resources even if the Academy closes for a time period. More details will come later.
- All steps are being taken to ensure that the Academy and residential halls are cleaned and disinfected regularly.
- If your child does get sick, they will receive the very best care possible. Please remember Foxcroft Academy is less than a mile from Mayo Regional Hospital.
- Your student will have a place to stay at Foxcroft Academy until national travel allows them to travel home.
- Please encourage your student to wash their hands frequently, to keep their room clean, and to let their dorm parents know if they feel ill. They are reminded daily about good hygiene protocols but it might be more effective coming from you.

Foxcroft Academy's strengths include a deep commitment to providing the very best for your child and we will treat your child like they are our own. We will continue to communicate with you as more information becomes available. It is important for you to know that your student is in good hands.
